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*ON SOME UNSOLVED PROBLEMS IN BULGARIAN GRAMMAR
IN THE CONTEXT OF THE GRAMMAR OF OTHER EUROPEAN LANGUAGES*

In this article I discuss four different problems in Bulgarian grammar, which all of them in one way or another seem to be connected with the notion “functional sentence perspective”: 1. *the coordinating conjunctions* а, и, но, 2. *the three articles: definite, indefinite and the “zero article”*, 3. *the subordinating conjunctions* да – че, 4. *verbal aspect in the imperative mood. Some comparisons with similar problems in some other European languages seem to indicate that after a closer application of the theory of “functional sentence perspective” to these problems, they may be looked upon from a partly new angle.*
