*THE IDEAL OF THE CZECH LITERARY LANGUAGE DURING THE PERIOD
OF THE CZECH NATIONAL REVIVAL*

Josef Dobrovsky's and Josef Jungmann's works and activities are often considered from various points of view. The present paper surveys their ideas about the Czech standard language. As representatives of the first and, respectively, the second generation of national revival activists, their deeds reflect their attitude to the language situation and language standardization of that time. J. Dobrovsky's ideal is the cultivated Czech language from the 16th century. This is the language of a past epoch and the way to enrich it is to revive archaic and obsolete words. J. Jungmann does not underestimate the older periods in the Czech language development, but he himself takes an active part in the enrichment of its vocabulary by creating a number of new words.

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
