*FROM HRISTO BOTEV TO THE THRESHOLD OF THE 21<sup>ST</sup> CENTURY...*

*Anniversary touches to the portrait of the scholar in Bulgarian philology Dana Hronková*

*The article introduces the life and the career of the literary scholar, Bulgarianist and translator Danushe (Dana) Hronková (b. February 6 in Stříbro). More specifically, the subject is the period of her studies at the Faculty of Arts of Charles University in Prague, as well as some highlights of her research and teaching activities. Special attention is paid to two projects in which she participated – the unpublished compendium *Dějiny bulharské literatury* [A History of Bulgarian Literature] and *Slovník spisovatelů – Bulharsko* [A Dictionary of Writers – Bulgaria], published in 1978. There is presented also her enormous editorial and translation work.*
