**DOCUMENTS FROM AND FOR BORIS YOTSOV
IN DIFFERENT ARCHIVES, LIBRARIES AND COLLECTIONS**

Abstract:

The paper presents a research on texts written both by the Bulgarian philologist Boris Yotsov and by others about him. In his work he was mainly interested in Slavic and particularly in Czech and Slovak studies. For instance, Prof. Yotsov focused on the writings and ideas of the poet Jan Kollar and Kollarism. The research in the archives of Yotsov showed that the Bulgarian scholar was not only interested in Slovak literature, but also published papers about Bulgarian authors in Slovak academic magazines. Boris Yotsov was maybe the first author who published an article in Bulgarian about a Slovak poet.
